## **Financial Goals**

Shirley's short-term goal is in four months she wants to visit her sister on the Gold Coast for a weekend. The cost of the trip will be \$450.00

As a long-term goal (in two years), she wants to buy a used car. She wants to pay \$6,000.00.

Given this information you need to create a budget for Sidney. You will need to do the following:

- 1. Calculate her expenses.
- 2. Calculate how much she needs to save a fortnight for her short-term goal.
- 3. Calculate how much she needs to save a fortnight for her long-term goal.
- 4. Determine how much she should save in her emergency fund.
- 5. Determine she can have to spend a fortnight.
